Tuesday, September 22 is National Voter Registration Day, a non-partisan civic holiday celebrating our democracy. Since 2012, nearly 3 million voters have registered to vote on this annual holiday.

The YMCA of Greenwich is proud to partner with the League of Women Voters Greenwich (LWV Greenwich), to celebrate National Voter Registration Day. We encourage all YMCA members to take two minutes to:

**Register to vote.** U.S. citizens who are 18 years of age by November 3, 2020, are eligible to vote in this year's election. <https://nationalvoterregistrationday.org/register-to-vote/>

**Confirm your voter registration status.** If you've recently moved or married, or if you haven't voted in the last several elections, you may need to re-register and confirm your polling location. <https://portaldir.ct.gov/sots/LookUp.aspx>.

**Request an Absentee Ballot.** Can't make it to the polls on November 3? Submit your request today! Ballots will be mailed starting October 2, and completed ballots must be received by-mail, or by-hand, by November 3. <https://portal.ct.gov/-/media/SOTS/ElectionServices/Absentee-Ballot-Application-ED-3/ED-3-Rev-20-Final.pdf>.
